



## Love City USA Chaperone Code of Conduct

### CHAPERONE DO'S

- Have fun, meet new chaperones and be friendly
- Be respectful of others and the camp property
- Participate in activities and Spiritual Encounter services
- Eat, sleep, and drink lots of water
- Only female chaperones in the girls' dormitory and only male chaperones in the boys' dormitory
- Use garbage cans for all trash
- Be a positive influence for campers
- Supervise your group of campers at all times

### CHAPERONE DON'TS

- No chaperone should be alone with a camper of the opposite gender
- No chaperone should provide any disciplinary actions to a camper of a different group
- No weapons, narcotics, graffiti, explicit material, or illegal items allowed (all bags will be checked prior to entry into any camp building)
- No profanity or inappropriate language on the campgrounds
- No smoking and fighting
- No public or private displays of affection
- No abuse of equipment or facilities

### CAMPER DISCIPLINARY POLICY

All campers will be handled with grace and love. The camper disciplinary policy is as follows:

- An initial verbal warning
- A time-out moment from some of the general activities and a discussion with the group leader and Love City USA Staff member
- A conversation with the Love City USA Director, Chaperone, and Parental Guardian, via phone, to determine the appropriate disciplinary actions. Campers who receive a time-out during camp will be documented for Love City USA records to cite the offense.
- Based on the severity of the violation, the penalty can be a removal from all activities, or the camper being sent home at their own expense with no refund.
