CAMP DO'S

- Have fun, meet new people and be friendly.
- Be respectful of others and the camp property.
- Be at all activities and Spiritual Encounter services on time
- Eat, sleep, and drink lots of water
- Only girls in the girls' dormitory and only boys in the boys' dormitory
- Use garbage cans for all trash

CAMP DON'TS

- No camper should be alone and without someone of the same gender.
- No weapons, narcotics, graffiti, explicit material or attire, or illegal items allowed (all bags will be checked prior to entry into any camp building)
- No profanity or inappropriate language on the campgrounds
- No smoking and fighting.
- No public or private displays of affection
- No abuse of equipment or facilities
- No hanging in the lobby or outside during Spiritual Encounter services



CAMPER DISCIPLINARY POLICY

All campers will be handled with discretion and grace. The camp disciplinary policy will be carried out as follows unless the offense calls for a greater measure:

- An initial verbal warning.
- A time-out moment from some of the general activities and a discussion with the group leader and Love City USA Staff member.
- If the offense is egregious or there are repeated offenses, there will be a conversation with the Love City USA Director, Chaperone, and Parental Guardian, via phone, to determine the appropriate disciplinary actions. All campers who receive a time-out moment during camp will be documented for Love City USA records to cite the offense.
- Based on the severity of the violation, the penalty can be a removal from all activities, or the camper being sent home at their own expense with no refund.
