SUITABLE TO BRING:

1. Bible
2. Recommended, but not required: at least \$30 to purchase Love City USA merchandise and concessions
3. A set of twin sheets and blanket or sleeping bag
4. 1 pillow and pillowcase
5. Towels and washcloths
6. Sweater or light jacket
7. Two pairs of jeans (minimum)
8. Shorts, shirts, & socks (primarily daily camp attire)
9. It is recommended to pack a minimum of 6 changes of clothes
10. Plastic bags for wet clothes
11. 2 pairs of tennis shoes
12. Flip Flops (for shower and beach front lake); swim or water shoes are encouraged
13. Toiletries, including but not limited to, a toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo and conditioner, deodorant, air freshener, feminine products for young ladies
14. Medication (must be given to the chaperone and will NOT be dispersed by Love City USA Staff)
15. Sunscreen and Insect Repellant
16. EMPTY Water bottle
17. Hat
18. Cameras are allowed
19. Cell phones are allowed, but can only be used during designated hours
20. Swim attire

What are the camp activities?

What is the age for campers?

The age is 13-19. No campers under the age of 13 or over the age of 19 will be permitted at camp.

Can campers bring their own snacks?

Campers are not permitted to bring their own snacks. Campers are encouraged to purchase snacks provided by the camp. There will be no food/grocery delivery allowed.

What is the lodging accommodation?

Male and female campers and chaperones will be lodged in separate dormitories in an atmosphere of excellence. The dormitories are a bunkhouse-style layout with multiple bunk beds in one area to fulfill the vision of fellowship and fun.



Will there be a lifeguard on staff?

Yes. Love City USA has certified (CPR and aquatics) lifeguards who will ensure the safety of all campers at the beach front lake.

Will there be a nurse on staff?

Yes. There will be a nurse available during select times and on-call in the event a medical situation arises.

What is the overall camp experience like?

There is a pre-set schedule for meals, activities, services, and fun to ensure campers leave with an overall positive and spiritual impact.

Will camper's bags be checked?

Upon arrival at check-in there is a security check of all bags/luggage. There will be security on the campgrounds throughout the camp session.
